Hollard Prestige v2.1 – Updated. Enhanced. Simplified.

We are pleased to announce that your current Prestige v1.5 policy will move to our enhanced Prestige v2.1 product, featuring a power surge update, as well as various new features, benefits and refinements, designed to further elevate our offering.

This communication aims to provide you with clear, concise information about these improvements and updates and reinforce our commitment to offering competitive, tailored cover for you.

What are the key product updates for Prestige v1.5 and Prestige v2.1?

- New benefits: Available under Home, Contents and Comprehensive Motor cover sections.
- Wider cover with new optional cover: Available under Home, Contents, Motor, Fine arts and Personal liability cover sections.
- New cover sections:
 - Cyber insurance (with five cover options), which includes theft of funds due to express kidnapping.
 - Extended personal liability.
 - Legal costs.
- New Limited cover option: Available under Home, Contents and Fine arts cover sections.
 - Excludes theft/attempted theft.
 - Reduced premium.
 - Catering to homes with a lower risk of theft.
- Items out and about benefit under Contents cover:
 - Cover for personal belongings, wherever you go, without listing specific items taken out of your home.
 - New cover limits available up to 30%.
 - Ideal if you have an active lifestyle or are a frequent traveller.
- Power surge
 - Included cover: Automatic cover is now limited to R50 000 under both the Home and Contents sections. No excess applies if a surge arrester meeting our requirements is installed on the home's main distribution board; otherwise, a Basic excess is payable.
 - Optional cover: We have introduced optional power surge cover that can be provided to you at an additional premium. A surge arrester is required for a combined sum insured above the threshold amount of R100 000. The threshold is assessed based on the combined total of your included Power surge benefit as stated in the Excess and limit section and any optional Power surge cover you selected that is shown in your policy schedule.
 - Threshold limit:
 - For cover up to R100 000 (the threshold limit), no surge arrester is required. There will be a Nil excess if an approved surge arrester is installed on the main distribution board of the home. If not installed, an excess of R2 500 will apply.

- For cover above R100 000, it is a condition of cover that an approved surge arrester must be installed on the main distribution board of the home and a Nil excess will apply if there is loss or damage. If an approved surge arrester is not installed, the cover will be limited to R100 000 and an excess of R2 500 will apply.
- Third-party claims (subrogation): We have updated this section to the wording to extend our recovery rights beyond common law (we can pursue a third-party recovery even if you have not been fully indemnified).
- Towing after mechanical or electrical breakdown: A new clause has been included, advising that if you suffer a mechanical or electrical breakdown, we will not cover the claim if the benefit is available on another policy.
- New for old (Vehicles younger than 24 months): We have clarified in the wording that, in the event of your vehicle being declared a total loss, the policy schedule may show the retail value, but we will replace the vehicle on a new-for-old basis, provided all conditions are met.
- Simplified Excess and limit structure: Including more selectable options under the basic excess under the Home, Contents, Assets specified, Motor vehicle and Motorcycle cover sections.
- Sasria: The Motor and Material Damage (Fire) cover sections have been updated with the latest Sasria wording, effective 1 August 2026 and any new policies concluded (or renewals) will be subject to the revised policy wording and Sasria regulations.

Which documents are attached?

We have attached your updated policy documents, including details on the product updates. Please read them carefully to familiarise yourself with the changes and to understand how they affect your cover.

- Policy wording – including all the terms, conditions and exclusions in an improved clarity and structure, aligned with Plain Language principles for better readability and understanding of the updated benefits and cover.
- Excess and limit section – outlining the updated applicable excesses and limits of your cover.
- ‘Important information about your cover’ document – highlighting the material aspects of the cover to help you understand your policy, key factors that affect your premium, exclusions, special terms and conditions and other relevant aspects of the policy.
- Policy wording and Excess and limit comparisons – reflecting colour-coded updates to show you the main differences between the cover and excess and limits of your current Prestige v1.5 and enhanced Prestige v2.1 product.
